The natural pool, which is a combination of pond and pool, makes it possible to enjoy naturally pure water without chemicals. Today, throughout the year it provides a visibly attractive alternative, one which an increasing number of garden owners prefer.

A wild garden with luxurious growth, for example, demands a naturally designed pond or a romantic dream-like water garden. If the planned natural pool borders directly on an architectural element such as a house or a terrace, the mixture of geometry and nature provides particular appeal. When designing a natural pool it is the art of the garden planner to consider all of the surrounding features and to include them in the design. Unattractive elements can be concealed and attractive ones emphasized by lighting and reflection. The character of the garden must be considered when the decision for the style and construction method of the pool is made. The natural pool should form a unity with the landscape, the region and the architecture. It can be both an effective eye-catcher and a calming design element that lends peace and harmony to the entire setting.

With a natural pool all combinations are possible: from nature to design, from ecology to high-tech. The realization of one's garden dream knows no boundaries.

Interest in the natural pool and the diverse possibilities for its design, but also the demands made on it, are on the rise: There is a growing number of customers who want to swim in crystal-clear water.
